

EMPLOYMENT SERVICES FOR UKRAINIAN NEWCOMERS (ESUN)



The Program provides employment services to Ukrainian Newcomers helping them to build employability skills and transitioning them to enter the workforce towards financial independence.

Target Group and Eligibility:

- Ukrainians arriving in Canada through the Canada-Ukraine Authorization for Emergency Travel (CUAET) pathway.
- A Ukrainian National with Temporary Residence status as defined by Immigration Refugee and Citizenship Canada
- Residing in Alberta and at least 18 years of age

The program offers:

- One-on-one career and employment session in your first language to assess your strengths and abilities, help you understand occupational options, develop doable employment plans and build your job search skills.
- Various Canadian job search workshops and increase clients opportunity to get employed. Workshop topics include career planning, resume writing, interview preparation, accessing employers, understanding the Canadian workplace, etc.
- employer connection/job placement support.
