- Support to look for permanent work
- Develop new skills to live and work in Canada

Do you qualify?

- Low-income immigrants/refugees to Canada
- Unemployed or underemployed and looking for a job
- Lack of Canadian work experience
- Commitment to a 12-week training and work experience
- Basic English language skills (CLB 3-5)
