

INTRODUCTION TO CANADIAN LOGISTICS (ICL) MICROCREDENTIAL



The program provides micro-credential logistics training and job search support for immigrants who want to pursue a career or work in the logistics industry.

Target Group and Eligibility:

- At least 18 years of age
- Residing in Alberta
- A Canadian citizen, permanent resident or legally entitled to work or train in Canada.
- Unemployed or underemployed with adequate English skills (CLB 5 and up) seeking to pursue a career or occupation in logistics.
- Ready, Willing, and Able to commit to a 4-week training.

Program offers:

- 3-week training towards advancing a career and gaining Microcredential in Canadian logistics
- 1-week employment and job search-themed workshop series
- Professional network support and job placement assistance
