

# EMPLOYMENT SERVICES FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITY



## Prepare, Reinforce, Employ and Promote People with Disabilities (PREP-PWD)

The program provides career and employment services, including workforce development to immigrants with disabilities, including mental health concerns.

### Target Group and Eligibility:

18+ years old, actively seeking employment.

Unemployed or marginally employed with disability or mental health concern.

Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or convention refugee eligible to work in Canada.

Willing to address barriers to gain employment.

Basic English proficiency: CLB 3+

### The program offers:

- Employment needs assessment and career planning
- Employment workshops and mental health-themed sessions (10 days)
- Paid work exposure (12 weeks)
- Funding for short courses
- Employer connection and job placement
- Job retention support
