Direct support will help clients navigate services, coordinate their care, and assist them in adapting to life in Canada, building the skills they need for daily living.

We will also coordinate Referrals and client accompaniment by connecting clients with the right services, including government and community programs, to ensure they get the help they need and have fewer obstacles in accessing support. Group support will also be assessed, and those who can benefit from this service will be moved toward group information and orientation support sessions. This approach will help clients with case management needs to become more independent and better manage their settlement and integration into Canada.
