The FCR program assists internationally educated health professionals in obtaining the necessary accreditation to practice in Canada. This initiative supports credential validation, licensing preparation, and integration into the Canadian healthcare workforce.

Eligibility:

• Open to internationally educated health professionals who are Canadian citizens, permanent residents, Open work permit holders or have protected person status in Canada.
