





Who can take these classes?

Permanent residents, refugees or Canadian citizens (18 years of age or older).

About the program

This program helps adult learners who have less than 7 years of education (primary/elementary level) improve their first language and English literacy skills.

Students will attend small classes with an instructor who speaks their first language. Lessons are designed based on learner needs and goals. Research shows that students who understand the basics of reading and writing in their first language will progress faster while learning to read and write in a second language.

Students attend regular classes in-person and schedule a small group or 1-on-1 tutoring session with their instructor throughout the week.

Please note: Childcare is not available for these classes.
