Who can take these classes?

Permanent residents and convention refugees (18 years of age or older).

About the Program

- helps learners improve English language and life skills through real-world tasks to succeed in Canadian society.
- uses Portfolio-Based Language Assessment (PBLA), which evaluates learners' listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills based on Canadian Language Benchmarks.
- delivers classes in person, blended, and online via the Provincial Online Model (POM) to accommodate students across Alberta.
- offers full-time and/or part-time:
 - » LINC Literacy classes
 - » Stage 1 (CLB1-4) classes
 - » Community-Based LINC Classes for Seniors aged 55+

These classes are free of cost and we accept continuous intake.
