Who can take these classes?

- Permanent residents and convention refugees (18 years of age or older)
- Adult learners have never been to school or have limited experience with the classroom environment and learning strategies.

About the Program

- Focuses on improving English skills with extra support for reading and writing practice.
- Incorporates digital literacy, numeracy, and cultural awareness through real-world tasks.
- Using Portfolio-Based Language Assessment (PBLA), which evaluates learners' listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills based on Canadian Language Benchmarks.

These classes are free of cost and we accept continuous intake.
